
## Orange, Black and White



An eye-catching addition to the Millwood skyline is the spanking-new paint job on the town's new 800,000-gallon standpipe water tank, a project recently completed by Structural Steel Painters, Inc., Portland, Ore. Use of orange and black (the school colors) was suggested by West Valley high school students. The job required 40 gallons of orange paint, 35 gallons of white and six gallons of black—and 45 gallons of primer. Forty-five gallons of paint were also used to paint the interior.
